#### CLIMATE PROTECTION AT MOTEL ONE

Climate

Protection

The climate is probably the most important environment-related topic.

Under the Paris Agreement, 195 countries agreed to limit global warming to substantially under  $2^{\circ}$ C, compared to the pre-industrial average global temperature. We support this target and are doing everything we can to reduce our CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.

#### **Carbon footprint**

Over the last few years, we have already implemented far-reaching measures to cut our  $CO_2$  emissions. This enabled us to reduce the  $CO_2$  value per overnight stay **by 45% in 2023, compared to 2019\*.** 

#### What we do to protect the climate

- 100% green electricity in our hotels
- Limited transport distances
- Expansion of vegetarian and vegan products on offer at our breakfast buffet
- Sustainable mobility solutions for our employees
- Gradual conversion of our company fleet to electric vehicles

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## GREEN BUILDINGS

### GREEN ELECTRICITY & ENERGY EFFICIENCY

Renewable energy is the most important element of a sustainable electricity supply. Since 2020, all of our existing hotels have used nothing but **renewable electricity**, from sources such as hydropower, solar power and wind power. In 2023, our electricity consumption came to 7.47 kWh per overnight stay.

#### Energy-saving measures at Motel One

- Modern LED lighting in our corridors, offices, technical rooms, underground car parks, stairwells and numerous guest rooms
- Guest rooms at Motel One are heated and cooled using energy-efficient convection fans
- Solar- and heat-control glass also prevents guest rooms from getting too warm, reducing the amount of air conditioning needed
- Regular consumption statistics and energy audits

#### WATER CONSUMPTION

A responsible approach to water is a key part of our sustainability strategy. This is why we use a range of methods to reduce our water consumption, such as using low-flow taps, shower heads and toilet cisterns to help protect the environment. Our standard toilet type has a two-button flush using 3-4 litres for the small button and 6-9 litres for the large one. In 2023, we used 156 litres of water per overnight stay. Our shower fittings use 16 litres of water per minute.

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## SUSTAINABLE DESIGN

We prioritise local manufacturers in every country and work with designers who use raw materials and materials responsibly. For example, German leather manufacturer Fiedler tans and dyes with natural materials, and the curtains from Swiss manufacturer Fischbacher are made from recycled polyester. The carpets in rooms and corridors from Danish company Ege are recyclable and Cradle to Cradle certified. That means less use of resources and a better indoor climate. As part of any redesign, existing furniture, carpets and curtains are salvaged where possible. Because a typical Motel One design needs not only to be high-quality and cosy, but also sustainable.

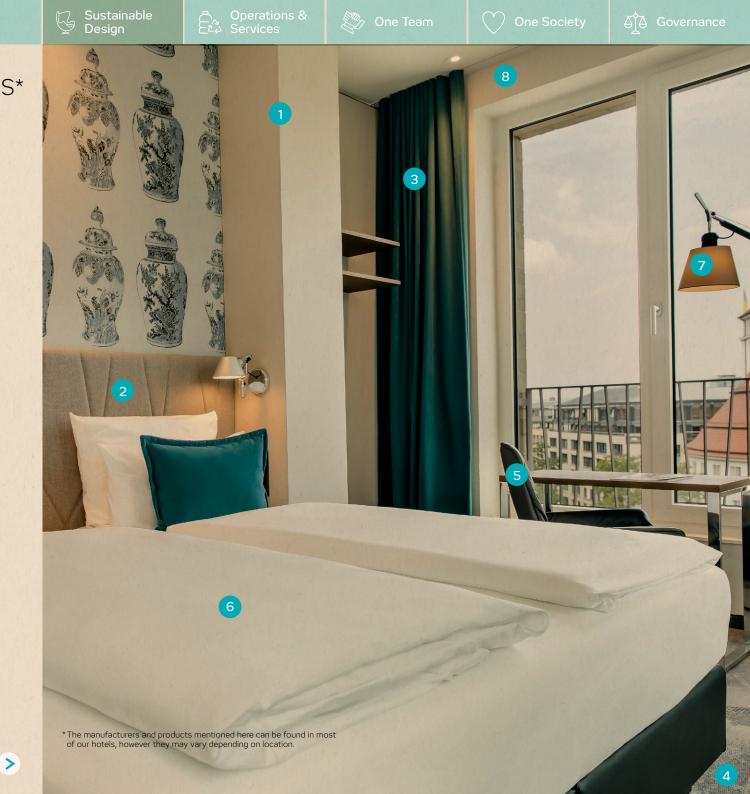

#### **GREEN KEY CERTIFICATION**

All Motel One Group hotels have been awarded the Green Key. The majority of the hotels in Germany have already received the certification.

Green Key is an independent environmental certification programme for hotels, hostels, campsites, holiday parks, small accommodation premises and conference centres, attractions and restaurants. Currently (May 2023), more than 4,000 companies in 60 countries are certified with the Green Key Label.

Green Key certification is based on compliance with strict, internationally recognised criteria in the areas of environmental management (water, energy, waste, cleaning, etc.) and sustainability education (employees, guests, suppliers, etc.), and is recognised by the GSTC (Global Sustainable Tourism Council).

Compliance with the criteria is ensured through a strict application procedure and verified with regular on-the-spot audits by third parties. The certification is valid for one year at a time.

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#### A VERY ORGANIC BREAKFAST

A good day begins with a good breakfast. That is why we place high value on organic and fair trade products when selecting food for our breakfast buffet.

There is a variety of organic cheeses, sausages, tomatoes, cucumbers, small fruit and eggs in our new breakfast concept, adding to the wide range of organic food already served in Germany and Austria. Across our group, all our eggs are free range at a minimum. In Germany, Austria, France, the Netherlands and Spain, all of our eggs are organic.\*

There are also lots of vegan options. Our buffet also has vegan Gouda, feta and sausage options, along with a vegan yoghurt alternative. We have also added an organic oat drink to our existing organic, soy and almond drink selection.

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#### SUSTAINABLE SERVICES & OPERATIONS

Climate

For every product used in our hotels, we ensure that we are systematically avoiding creating waste, we separate rubbish, and we prioritise the use of reusable packaging. We also involve our suppliers in our waste reduction activities and mostly have products delivered in bulk.

#### Steps to avoid plastic

- Switching from plastic cups to biodegradable cups: around 2.8 million plastic cups saved annually\*
- Removing plastic bin bags in bathrooms: around 5.7 million plastic bags saved annually\*
- Majority of the food items without individual packaging at the breakfast buffet
- 100% microplastic-free, natural toiletries in bathrooms

The vegan toiletries provided to guests at Motel One avoid plastics in two ways. The refillable pump dispensers are made from recycled PET and are reused many times over. We use and dispose of only three to four dispensers per product (handwash and hair and body shampoo) in each room each year. The two products provided are Ecocert and Cosmebio certified and **do not contain microplastics**.

Moreover, all cleaning products used at Motel One are completely free of microplastics, biodegradable and certified with the EU Ecolabel.

### My Service Option

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We always want to offer our guests the very best service. That is why room cleaning comes as standard at Motel One. But with our My Service Option, guests always have the opportunity to voluntarily do without having their room cleaned. This enables us to save precious resources like water and electricity and minimise the amount of cleaning products used.

For every clean not undertaken, we save:

13.43 Liter of water 0.03 kWH of electricity 32.43 ml of cleaning products

On the fourth day of a stay, we do a room check to empty the bins and top up the bathroom products. If you need anything before this point, just let us know!

# ONE SOCIETY

We use our foundation, the One Foundation, to live up to our social and societal responsibility. Established in 2018, the One Foundation's mission is to offer altruistic support to the disadvantaged, particularly in areas including social integration, training courses and education both at school and at work.

Our funding projects primarily support socially and economically disadvantaged young people, helping to give them new prospects. Projects supported in 2023 included:

- **Building schools in Malawi:** With the opening of three schools and a nursery in Malawi, more than 2,200 children have now gained access to education. The opening of an additional school is planned for September 2024.
- **PLAN A**, a Joblinge initiative, motivates young people in Germany to access the training market. Individual coaching and group workshops help them to find their career path.
- The SchlaUA project, funded by the association **Junge Flüchtlinge e. V.** in Munich, helps young Ukrainian refugees to gain their school leaving qualifications in Germany.
- With the 'Über den Tellerrand' project (literally 'over the edge of the plate', meaning 'to take a broader view'), the Gastro Academy in Munich offers training courses for people with experience of migration and being a refugee, so that they can find employment in the catering industry on a qualified basis.
- The **Refugio Munich Art Workshop** offers young people who have experienced life as a refugee the opportunity to deal with traumatic experiences through the medium of art.

In addition, the One Foundation awarded a scholarship for trainees in the hotel and restaurant industry for the first time in 2023.

## GOVERNANCE

#### ONE COMPLIANCE

We are aware of our responsibilities and have jointly undertaken to perform our day-to-day work in line with our underlying values and in accordance with the applicable law. One Compliance helps us to do so.

Our **Code of Conduct** – the One Code – in particular is intended as an aid in making the right decisions, standing up for our values and implementing them in our daily lives. The One Code applies to our entire One family, including our executive management and our supervisory board.

The One Code is supplemented by an array of internal guidelines, especially on combating corruption and bribery, money laundering, protecting human rights, data protection and IT security. All our employees are trained in One Compliance and any breaches can be reported anonymously via our whistleblowing tool, which is also available to all external staff (e.g. cleaning staff).

Since 1 January 2024, we are bound by the Supply Chain Act (LkSG). With our risk management system we monitor our own business area as well as our suppliers and service providers in accordance with the requirements of the LkSG.
